A HALF DAY CYCLO TOUR IN HUE – HIGHLIGHTS OF HUE

The Imperial Citadel – Khai Dinh Mausoleum – Dong Ba Market

Established as the capital of unified Vietnam in **1802**, Hue was not only the **political, cultural, and religious center** under the **Nguyen Dynasty** until **1945** but also a cradle of imperial heritage and rich traditions.



➤ ITINERARY

Start your journey with a **cyclo ride** to **The Imperial Citadel**, where the Nguyen emperors ruled from **1802 to 1945**. Recognized as a **UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1993**, this vast complex showcases the elegance of Vietnam’s last feudal dynasty through **massive stone walls, ornate gates, and tranquil courtyards**. Hue Citadel is divided into two sections: the **Imperial City**, where the Emperor governed, and the **Forbidden City**, an exclusive royal residence where only the Emperor, his family, and eunuch servants were permitted entry.

Continue to the **Mausoleum of Khai Dinh**, a unique blend of **Vietnamese tradition and European influences**, making it distinct from other royal mausoleums in Hue. Built between **1920 and 1931**, the mausoleum is renowned for its **intricate dragon carvings, elaborate mosaics, and a lavish throne hall** reflecting **Hindu, Buddhist, Roman, and Gothic elements**.

Before returning to your hotel, **stroll through Dong Ba Market**, Hue’s **largest and oldest market**, where colorful stalls overflow with fresh produce, handcrafted souvenirs, and Hue’s signature delicacies like **bánh bèo, bánh nậm, and mè xúng**. It’s the perfect spot to experience the city’s vibrant local life.

A HALF DAY CYCLO TOUR IN HUE – INSIDER HUE

Dong Ba Market - Ho Quyen Tiger Arena - Tu Hieu Pagoda - An Dinh Palace

Hue is a city steeped in history, culture, and breathtaking architecture. As the former capital of unified Vietnam and the seat of the Nguyen Dynasty, it offers a wealth of **imperial heritage**, **tranquil pagodas**, and fascinating landmarks that capture the essence of Vietnam's royal past.



➤ ITINERARY

Start your day with a cyclo ride to Dong Ba Market, one of Hue's must-see sites. The market's colorful stalls are filled with local goods, fresh produce, and vibrant street food—providing a perfect glimpse into everyday life in Hue.

From here, **transfer by vehicle** to the **beautiful Tu Hieu Pagoda**, dating back to **1843**. Nestled in a serene pine forest, this monastery was once home to **Zen Master Thich Nhat Hanh**. The pagoda is notable for its **eunuch mausoleums**, which are unique to Hue and not found in any other part of the city. These mausoleums provide a glimpse into the intriguing history of the Nguyen Dynasty's court.

Next, head to **Ho Quyen**, an **historical arena** where **duels between elephants and tigers** were held for the entertainment of the Nguyen emperors. The last fight took place here in **1904**. You can climb the nearby ramparts and look down upon the arena, imagining the fierce battles once staged for imperial amusement.

Finally, visit **An Dinh Palace** (closed on Mondays), where you'll admire magnificent **wall and ceiling murals** and a stunning **facade** that blends **oriental and European architectural styles**. Originally built in 1902 by **Phung Hoa Cong Nguyen Phuc Buu Dao** (later **Emperor Khai Dinh**), the palace was later renovated using the emperor's personal funds. After 1975, the palace was donated to the government and used as dormitories for university professors. It fell into disrepair until being **restored in 2001**, bringing back its former splendor.

Perfume River Boat Cruise - Thien Mu Pagoda – The Imperial Citadel – Tu Duc's Mausoleum

Start your day with a leisurely boat trip upstream along the **famous Perfume River**, a scenic journey that leads you to **Thien Mu Pagoda**, a defining symbol of Hue. Built in **1601**, the pagoda's iconic **seven-story tower** represents the seven reincarnations of Buddha. It is one of the oldest and most revered pagodas in Vietnam.

The citadel, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, showcases the **golden age of the Nguyen emperors**, featuring **grand gates, palaces, and temples**. After exploring the citadel, continue to the **Mausoleum of Tu Duc**. Constructed years before the emperor's death, the mausoleum served as **Tu Duc's retreat** and is an architectural marvel. The mausoleum is set in a tranquil garden surrounded by lakes and pine trees, symbolizing peace and reflection. It is one of the most beautiful and well-preserved royal mausoleums in Hue.

Finish the half-day tour with a relaxing return to the hotel for a leisurely lunch, reflecting on the rich history and culture you've experienced.

Perfume River Boat Cruise – Thien Mu Pagoda - Khai Dinh – Minh Mang

Hue is a city steeped in history, with a blend of cultural landmarks and serene landscapes that tell the story of Vietnam’s royal past. Known for its iconic pagodas, royal mausoleums, and powerful historical moments, Hue offers an unforgettable journey through time.



➤ ITINERARY

Start your day with a leisurely boat trip upstream along the **romantic Perfume River**, a scenic and peaceful journey leading you to **Thien Mu Pagoda**. Built in **1601**, this iconic pagoda, with its **seven-story tower**, represents the seven reincarnations of Buddha and is considered the unofficial symbol of Hue. The pagoda’s grounds also house the **Austin car**, which gained fame when a **monk drove it to Saigon in 1963** to protest against the southern regime. His self-immolation, captured in an iconic photo, became one of the most powerful images of the **American-Vietnam War**.

Next, **drive to the Mausoleum of Khai Dinh**, a striking blend of **traditional Vietnamese design with European influences**, making it unique among Hue’s royal mausoleums. The mausoleum’s **intricate mosaics, stunning architecture, and cross-cultural influences** make it one of the most impressive mausoleums in the region.

Afterward, continue to the **Mausoleum of Minh Mang**, situated in a tranquil setting of **gardens and ponds**. This mausoleum, surrounded by nature, is an epitome of imperial harmony and reflects the philosophical and spiritual beliefs of the former emperor. The serene environment makes it an ideal spot to reflect on the grandeur of the Nguyen Dynasty.

The Imperial Citadel – Hue Royal Fine Art Museum – Tu Duc's Mausoleum – Tu Hieu Pagoda

Hue, the former capital of Vietnam, offers a rich tapestry of history, culture, and royal heritage. From grand imperial palaces to serene pagodas, the city immerses visitors in the splendor of the Nguyen Dynasty and its lasting legacy.

Your first visit will be to **The Imperial Citadel**, where the **Nguyen Dynasty** ruled from **1802 to 1945**. An Hien Garden Houses - Tha Om Garden House - Ngoc Son Princess Temple Garden House

Hue, once the heart of the **Nguyen Dynasty**, is home to a series of beautiful garden houses that reflect the city’s cultural values and harmoniously blend **traditional architecture** with the **natural landscape**. These peaceful and elegant spaces provide a glimpse into the imperial lifestyle and are increasingly popular with tourists seeking to experience Hue’s charm and tranquility.



➤ ITINERARY

Start your visit at An Hien Garden House, one of the most renowned in Hue. Built in the late 19th century, this 4,608-square-meter estate was originally the residence of the 18th daughter of Emperor Duc Duc, the fifth emperor of the Nguyen Dynasty. Besides being a royal residence, the garden house served as a place of worship and a venue for receiving high-ranking officials and scholars visiting the Imperial City.

Continue to Tha Om Garden House, a tranquil retreat with lush gardens and elegant traditional architecture. As you explore, take in the harmonious lifestyle reflected in these homes—where nature and heritage intertwine. Savor a cup of tea and sample Hue’s traditional sweets, graciously offered by the hosts, and experience the warmth of local hospitality.

End your tour at Ngoc Son Princess Temple Garden House, the former residence of **Princess Ngoc Son**, daughter of **Emperor Dong Khanh**. This garden house is a prime example of **feng shui** principles in design. The **hòn non bộ** (miniature mountain) in the garden symbolizes **strength and stability**, while the **bể cạn** (shallow pond) is carefully placed to attract **positive energy and prosperity**. In front of the house, the **hồ sen** (lotus pond) adds an element of **purity and serenity**, inviting peace and good fortune. These features create a balanced, harmonious atmosphere, which was essential to the lifestyle of royalty.

Kim Dai Pagoda – Khai Dinh Mausoleum - Hon Chen Temple – Nam Giao Esplanade

Step into Hue’s spiritual heart on a half-day journey that weaves sacred rituals, cultural heritage, and moments of personal reflection. Set against the poetic backdrop of the ancient capital, this curated pilgrimage invites you to reconnect with tradition, pay homage to the past, and seek blessings for the future.

➤ ITINERARY

Begin at **Kim Dai Pagoda**, where you’ll take part in morning chanting, receive Buddhist blessings, and enjoy a tranquil tea-time conversation with the head monk. Deepen your spiritual awareness by drawing a fortune stick—*xin xām*—revealing insights and guidance for the year ahead.

Continue to the magnificent **Khai Dinh Mausoleum**, an architectural masterpiece blending Vietnamese and European elements. Here, pay tribute to the past by lighting an incense stick at the central altar, offering prayers for harmony, happiness, and good fortune.

Next, visit **Hon Chen Temple**, newly recognized as a National Intangible Cultural Heritage (March 30, 2025). Nestled on the lush banks of the Perfume River, this sacred site honors both Champa and Vietnamese deities through royal ceremonies and folk traditions. Absorb its mystical energy, admire the scenic setting, and seek divine blessings for health, protection, and prosperity.

Conclude your journey at the historic **Nam Giao Esplanade**, the ceremonial site where Nguyễn Emperors once held *Lễ tế trời đất*—rituals dedicated to Heaven and Earth. These sacred rites, revived in recent years, are now presided over by high-ranking dignitaries offering prayers for national peace and the people’s well-being (*Quốc thái dân an*). Join this profound tradition by lighting incense and offering your own prayers for personal success, happiness, and a harmonious future.

A HALF DAY CRAFT VILLAGES AROUND HUE

Thanh Toan Bridge - Thanh Tien & Sinh Villages

Hue is a city rich in cultural heritage, and a journey into its surrounding countryside reveals even more of its traditional craftsmanship and historic landmarks. This tour will take you through rural villages where age-old techniques have been preserved for generations, offering a deep dive into Vietnam's local culture and history.



➤ ITINERARY

Depart your hotel with your tour guide and head by car to visit **Thanh Toan Bridge**, a historical landmark built **over two centuries ago**. The **tile-roofed bridge** is one of only two in Vietnam, with the other located in **Hoi An**. It was built by the wife of a high-ranking Mandarin as a tribute to the villagers, and in the past, it served as a **shelter for the disadvantaged** during the winter months. The bridge has endured **storms, floods, and wars**, symbolizing the resilience of the local community. After exploring the bridge, take some time to stroll through the **village's morning market**, where you can find local produce and handmade goods.

Next, continue on to the **village of Thanh Tien**, traditionally known for its paper flower craftsmanship. For centuries, local artisans have created these flowers using **time-honored techniques** passed down through generations. The flowers are commonly used in **religious services** and as offerings during **traditional events**, such as the Tet - Lunar New Year festival.

A short distance from Thanh Tien, visit the **Sinh Woodblock Printing Village** located along the lower section of the **Perfume River**. This traditional village is known for its **vibrant woodblock prints**, which are typically used during the **Lunar New Year** for **ancestor worship rituals**. The prints depict scenes of daily life, deities, and mythical creatures, adding color to celebrations. While there, you'll have the chance to visit **family homes**, meet the artisans, and learn about the **age-old techniques** they use to create these beautiful prints.

PRINCESS NGOC SON'S TEMPLE GARDEN HOUSE

Hue, with its rich history and vibrant culture, is home to landmarks offering glimpses into the past. **Princess Ngoc Son's Garden House** is a historic garden that reflects Hue's architectural and cultural heritage, revealing the royal history of the Nguyen Dynasty and connecting visitors to its traditions.



➤ ITINERARY

Princess Ngoc Son's Garden House is located in the **Gia Hoi landscape**, east of Hue's **Imperial City**. Built to honor **Princess Ngoc Son**, daughter of **Emperor Dong Khanh** (1885–1889), and wife of **Nguyen Huu Tien**, head of the **Nguyen military**, the house was constructed in **1921** by **Nguyen Huu Tien** on a **2,400m²** plot. It became home to **Nguyen Huu Tien**, his second wife, and seven children. For over **90 years**, the descendants of **Nguyen Huu Tien** have preserved the house, despite changes in **Gia Hoi** and **Hue**.

A key feature of the house is its **fengshui** design. At the front, a **hòn non bộ** (miniature mountain) symbolizes the connection between nature and architecture. The **bể cạn** (shallow pond) adds to the calm atmosphere, while the **hồ sen** (lotus pond) symbolizes purity and prosperity. These elements were carefully placed to bring harmony to the home.

The house is currently owned by **Mrs. Nguyen Thi Suong**, the granddaughter of **Nguyen Huu Tien**, and her husband, **Mr. Phan Thuan An**, a historian. Their deep knowledge of **Hue's culture** ensures the house's preservation, a legacy passed to their three children, who also work in **heritage conservation**.

A visit to **Princess Ngoc Son's Garden House** offers a chance to explore traditional **Hue Garden house** architecture and discover the lifestyle of its people, providing a glimpse into **Hue's heritage**.

Hue, known for its rich cultural history, is equally renowned for its unique and flavorful cuisine. This food trail invites you to dive into the local flavors and traditions that have shaped this former imperial city’s culinary scene. Hop on a **cyclo** ride along the ancient walls of the “**Great Enclosure – Dai Noi**” and get ready to embark on a journey of authentic **Hue cuisine**.



➤ INITERARY

Start your journey in **Kim Long**, where the fresh-rice rolls with grilled pork at **Huyen Anh restaurant** are an absolute must-try. These delicious rolls offer a perfect balance of flavors and are a popular dish in Hue.

Next, discover **Banh Khoai Lac Thien**, a crispy Hue pancake filled with shrimp and pork. This dish is made by a talented deaf family who also crafts novelty bottle openers. They are well-known among the expat community in Vietnam for both their delicious food and unique craftsmanship.

Continue your journey to **Hanh Restaurant**, where you can sample **Beo, Nam, Loc**, some of the most famous specialties in Hue. These delicate rice cakes are served with a variety of tasty accompaniments and are a favorite among locals.

No food tour in Hue would be complete without a taste of the local sweet treats. The next stop is **Che Hem** on **Hung Vuong Street**, a dessert haven where you’ll find over 15 different types of **Hue sweet soups**.
